### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

Candidate shall possess the proper certification from the Department of Public Instruction; or be eligible for emergency permit. Candidate shall possess a minimum of two years teaching experience. Is qualified by training, experience, expert level of technology and 21<sup>st</sup> century learning, understanding, and application and ability to meet the exacting needs of the school and community. The STEM teacher will identify resources, plan, and design staff development activities to support professional growth in learning technologies. Participate in professional development experiences that allow him or her to observe, evaluate, and apply the use of technology to support instruction.
