Candidate shall possess the ability to communicate clearly with young children and adults, the ability to write Individual Educational Plans (IEP), possess working knowledge of IDEA Law and procedures, experience of working with young children aged 3-6 years old, possess the ability to work both independently and in a team setting, and must have good written and verbal communication skills.
