The Menominee Indian School District has a full time position available as a Menominee Language teacher at the Menominee Indian Middle School for the 2024-25 school year.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Candidate shall possess a Wisconsin DPI certification to teach Menominee Language. Candidate shall also possess certification from the Menominee Language & Culture Commission.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Candidate shall be able to demonstrate knowledge of language acquisition theory, develop and implement an effective Menominee Language program. Develop daily lesson plans that demonstrate an applied method of scope and sequence in the curriculum that enhances continual oral language development in the Menominee Language. The ability to teach flute, drumming, (traditional and contemporary), singing for male and female students, dancing (grass, fancy and traditional) is considered a plus.
