Plan to Attend MISD Annual Meeting

On September 27, MISD will hold its Budget Hearing and Annual Meeting. Leaders are asking the public attend to learn more about future facilities planning.

Over the course of the past 18 months, the administration and School Board have been studying and evaluating facility needs throughout the district; approving several projects and continuing to evaluate others.

"We are encouraging everyone to attend this meeting so they can learn more," stated Superintendent Wendell Waukau. "We are here to serve our community's students, so it is always helpful when our parents, teachers, taxpayers and others provide feedback on our plans."

Earlier this year, the Board approved two projects: the expansion of Keshena Primary School (KPS) and construction of a new bus garage; both of which will be paid for using available funding.

KPS Expansion

KPS is out of space, so there is a need for additional class-rooms as well as ways to incorporate outdoor learning concepts, which were identified as focus areas through the District's strategic planning project.

New Bus Garage



The new bus/district vehicle garage project is temporarily on hold while the district monitors building material costs and supply chain challenges. As you undoubtedly know, the pandemic has caused problems in both areas.

The new bus garage will also provide seasonal storage so district buses and other vehicles can be stored and maintained inside the building. This will help buses start up even in the coldest weather and will provide room for indoor maintenance throughout the year.

"This will not only improve reliability, but should also extend the life of the vehicles," stated MISD Board Chair David "Jonesy" Miller.

Net-Zero High School

To meet longer term needs, the District is researching and evaluating the feasibility of building a new, net-zero high school.

A net-zero school is a green school that produces as much, or more energy than it uses. This is achieved through the use of efficient, renewable energy systems that produce the amount of energy required to operate the facility.

Net-zero schools generally incorporate solar panels, natural lighting, geothermal heating and cooling, collaboration areas, small group instruction areas, outdoor classroom spaces and other features. "Creating a safe, effective and inspiring learning and teaching environment is what we are after," stated Waukau. "There are so many learning opportunities that come with this type of building. We want to take a thorough look at the possibilities." Waukau stressed no decisions have been made at this point, which is why it is a good opportunity for

community members to weigh in with their thoughts and opinions. "It's an exciting time in the District as we look to the future, so now is the perfect time to share your thoughts with us," he added.
