- Thanks to focused outreach and education efforts, our vaccination rates among teachers, staff and students continue to increase.

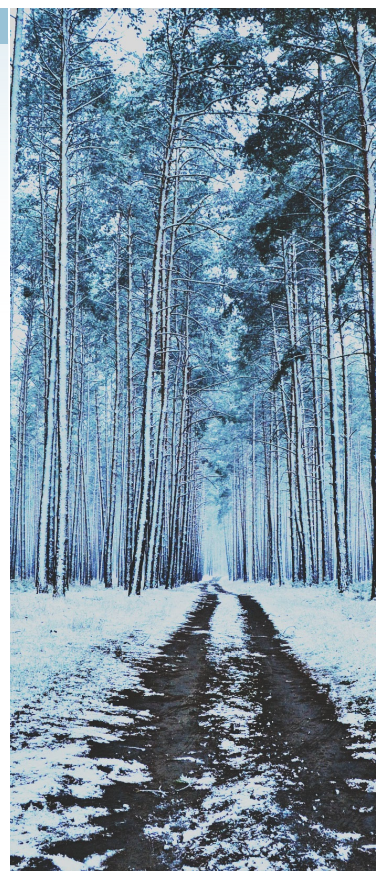
- Our student athletes are competing once again.

### Did You Know?

MIHS partners with three area higher educational institutions: College of Menominee Nation, Northeast Wisconsin Technical College and North Central Technical College to provide college prep programming, dual credit enrollment, workshops, and technical skills training.

MIHS, in collaboration with NWTC-Shawano, offers high school juniors and seniors the opportunity to enroll in a college program.

The 4x4 Program, located at NWTC-Shawano, allows students to attend college

classes each morning, while continuing their high school studies.

The college classes, which are dual-credit and paid for by MISD, can be counted toward high school graduation requirements as well.
